A signal person is required when the point of operation is not in full view of the operator, the operator's view is obstructed in the direction the equipment is traveling or because of site-specific safety concerns.

Qualified Signal training will cover:

- Know and understand the type of signals used at the worksite level
- Is competent in using these signals
- Understands the operations and limitations of the equipment, including the crane dynamics involved in swinging, raising, lowering and stopping loads and in boom deflection from hoisting loads

As of November 8, 2010 employers must ensure there signal person is qualified, with a third party evaluator or with an employers qualified evaluator.
